NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE TO OUR CANCELLATION PENALTIES. To avoid these penalties, Pathway Tours strongly recommends that passengers purchase cancellation and medical protection through their travel agent. For complete information refer to back cover.

DOCUMENTS

Your passenger ticket, itinerary, hotel list, luggage tags and name badge will be sent to your travel agent approximately 14 days prior to your departure. **In some cases, when we have several coaches travelling on a tour, your agent may not receive your documents until 7-10 days prior to your departure. It is the responsibility of the travel agent and the passenger to double check the passenger ticket copy for the departure time & place.**

THE RIGHT ID

There are some border crossing requirements as outlined on the web site at www.dhs.gov and go to travel requirements. Please inquire with your travel agent or visit this web site. Upon booking your tour with the appropriate deposit, you will be sent a complete information sheet.

TRANSPORTATION

All highway equipment used on Pathway Tours is chartered through a variety of professional, licensed motorcoach companies. All are regulated and inspected frequently by the Ministry of Transportation. The coaches, in most cases, will range from 47 passenger to 56 passenger capacity and will be fully equipped for your comfort. In the event that it is a small group, we reserve the right to provide a smaller motorcoach which will still be fully equipped, properly licensed and, again, regulated and inspected frequently by the Ministry of Transportation. In all cases, you will be provided with a professional, trained, licensed, bonded and insured driver. All motorcoaches are non-smoking.

SEAT ROTATION (Mandatory)

It is the fairest way we know to allow everyone to try different views in the coach and meet new people across the aisle. **We do not reserve seats.**

TOUR ESCORTS AND GUIDES

Our tour escorts are with you to co-ordinate all details of our itinerary, ensure that the appropriate stops are made and that your check-in and check-out of hotels is as prompt as possible. They work closely with the driver in an effort to provide you with a perfect holiday. Local tour guides, who specialize in their own particular area, have been hired to conduct all of our guided tours and they will provide you with all of the pertinent details of their city or area.

LUGGAGE

Each passenger will be provided with handling costs of **one large suitcase** on tours 3 days or longer. You may also carry a **small overnight case on board**. Luggage tags are provided.

YOUR HOTEL

Our hotels and motels are, in most cases, rated as **two to four star** (which denotes very good to outstanding) in the Official Lodging Directory of the American Hotel and Motel Association. Some areas do not offer a large selection of accommodations but, in this event, **we choose the best available**. Rooms are allocated by hotel staff but if you have a special request, please advise us when making reservations. Requests may not always be possible but we will do our best.

CONTINENTAL BREAKFASTS

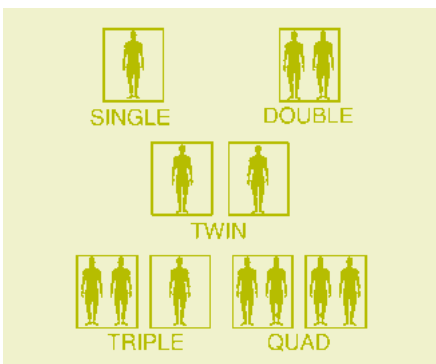
Whenever included in your tour, we will try to upgrade the basic continental breakfast to an expanded continental breakfast, at no additional cost to you.

3-5 This morning we depart Quebec City and visit the wood carver's at Pt. Joli, before leaving the province of Quebec.
